We intend for camp to help kids and students engage in their phase of life:

Current **3rd-5th grade** students attend **Camp Blast**

Current **6th-7th grade** students attend **Middle School Camp**

Current **8th-12th grade** students attend **High School Camp**

Due to the generosity of the people of Hope Church, costs have been offset for each age group. Camp costs:

**Camp Blast:** \$260 (+\$50 after 9pm on May 26)

**Middle School Camp:** \$245 (+\$50 after 9pm on April 28)

**High School Camp:** \$315 (+\$50 after 9pm on April 28)


**A non-refundable \$50 deposit is due to secure registration for participants.**

## CAMP BLAST | JULY 22-26

Every kid who attends Camp Blast is placed in cabin groups with vetted and trained Counselors and Assistant Counselors to lead, care, and guide the group all week long. Each kid should select their "Activity Zone" choice to ensure they get the chance to participate in their desired afternoon options!

### ACTIVITY ZONE OPTIONS (Select these on Registration Form)

#### ACTIVE ADVENTURE Opportunities:

Basketball, Flag Football, Dodgeball, Kickball, Climbing Wall, & Zip Line

#### Fun Wilderness Opportunities:

Nature Center, Crafts, Group Games, Scavenger Hunt, Canoes & Kayaks, Archery, Hiking

Transportation for each camp is provided by *Excursions*. Each kid will be transported via coach bus or HMC road-worthy passenger vans.

#### PHYSICAL, MENTAL, EMOTIONAL CONDITIONS OR LEARNING DISABILITIES:

We work hard to accommodate all kids desiring to attend Camp BLAST. However, we have certain staffing and facility limitations and may not be able to adapt to all situations without help from parents and the local church. PLEASE be honest and open with us on any situations campers may have so we can work together to make Camp BLAST a great time for all campers and staff. *(please indicate on registration.)*



Included in each campers costs is a \$5 snack card which allows them to get a drink and a snack each day, Tuesday-Thursday. Kids will not need additional funds for snacks and drinks. Additionally, due to the generosity of the people of Hope Church, all kids receive a stipend of \$85 per camper.

***This stipend will be reflected at the end of your registration process.***
