We intend for camp to help kids and students engage in their phase of life: Current **3rd-5th grade** students attend **Camp Blast** 

Current 6th-7th grade students attend Middle School Camp Current 8th-12th grade students attend High School Camp

Due to the generosity of the people of Hope Church, costs have been offset by \$100 for each age group. Camp costs for 2025:

Camp Blast: \$250 (+\$30 after 11:59pm on May 26)

Middle School Camp: \$215 (+\$30 after 11:59p on May 5)

High School Camp: \$285 (+\$30 after 11:59p on May 5)

ALL Payments available via Credit Card in 2025!

A non-refundable \$50 deposit is due to secure registration for participants.

Included camp registration is all lodging, meals, programming, recreation activities, transportation fee (half is covered by HMC Year End Project Funds), and camp shirt.

Every student who attends Middle School Camp or High School Camp is placed in grade/gender specific housing with leaders to walk alongside them all week long. These small groups often become the space where perspective and life change can happen when they get home.

Transportation for each camp is provided by *Excursions*. Each student will be transported via coach bus or HMC road-worthy passenger vans.



Both Student Camps feature main sessions with worship, teaching, and interactive engagement. Additionally, meaningful Time Alone With God experiences are built into the camp experience to help students dig deeper in their personal discipleship of Jesus.
